Jean E. Denis is the Director of Information System of Africare. He oversees the operation of the corporate information system with the goal of meeting its business objectives with the allocated IT resources. His responsibilities include software and hardware operations, system security, and management of the IT personnel and consultants. Mr. Denis has been working in the Development field as an IT professional for more than 20 years. Before being promoted, Mr. Denis was an Information Systems Specialist for Africare.

Mr. Denis spent 3 years in Rwanda as the Administrative Officer for Africare from 1984 to 1987. He oversaw the financial and administrative operation of the country office. Before joining Africare, Mr. Denis worked with the Defense Logistic Agency as an Application Programmer from 1983 thru 1984. He was responsible for writing and maintaining business applications. In 1980 thru 1983, Mr. Denis worked as a Peace Corps Volunteer in the country of Senegal. He worked in the village of Batal and the capital Dakar, designing and implementing income-generation activities in the areas of animal husbandry, reforestation, energy conservation and milling machine maintenance and management.

Mr. Denis obtained his Bachelor's degree in Telecommunications from Indiana University in 1979, with a minor in Mathematics and Computer Science. He has attended training in Lawson Financial Management, Novell Network Administration, AS/400 Administration, RPG, and Delphi programming languages. His programming environment includes Delphi, Visual Studio.Net 2008, Alpha 5, and IBM DB/2 database. He is also proficient with VMWARE, Windows 2008 Server, and MS SQL Server 2008.
